About Red Feather Ranch

Red Feather Ranch is a nonprofit organization located in Philomath, Oregon that reconnects women veterans to their authentic selves through earth-based practices and a supportive community of sister veterans. We believe that we can heal our trauma through building a connection with the land and our community. We embrace a variety of evidence-based, holistic and trauma-informed approaches to promote the healing of women veterans from trauma, whether it be sexual, combat-related, grief-related, generational, or childhood trauma.

Currently, we provide online support groups and skills coaching groups for women veterans. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we are not offering in-person programs at this time. We are in the process of expanding our programming and will be offering retreats and vocational training in sustainable agriculture and food production.

Position Overview

The MSW Intern for Red Feather Ranch will work closely with the Executive Director to co-facilitate the online women veterans group meetings, assist with program evaluation and planning, and to support the organization's communications and development needs. **Military or military veteran women are highly encouraged to apply**

We are looking for applicants who are seeking to fulfill requirements for either their generalist or advanced-level field placements as a part of their MSW program. Interns will be expected to work two consecutive semesters. Supervision will be provided by the Executive Director who holds a MSW. We are flexible with our schedule/hours but ask that you be able to commit at least 8 hours per week and work at least one weekday (Monday-Friday) per week.

Job Responsibilities:

- Co-facilitate the virtual Women Veteran's Healing Room and Women Veteran's Cohort meetings with the Executive Director
- Develop outreach strategies to spread the word about the Healing Room and Cohort Program
- Design and conduct surveys with existing clients to evaluate program effectiveness and cultural competence



- Manage and create content for the organization's social media pages
- Produce content for compose email communications between organization and subscribers/donors
- Maintain donation and giving records
- Assist with grant research & writing as well as fundraising planning and execution
- Assist with other projects as needed

Experience & Essential Skills:

- Must be able to work independently
- Fast learner, able to quickly learn new data-management software and programs
- Must be able to maintain confidentiality and work in a professional manner
- Must be able to maintain appropriate boundaries
- Must be comfortable working with diverse populations and individuals who experienced trauma
- Must have strong organizational and time management skills
- Due to the remote nature of the internship, intern prospects are required to have regular access to a computer and cell phone
- Prior non-profit, veteran's-focused, or general program administration experience preferred
- Military or military veteran women are highly encouraged to apply

Prerequisites:

- Must hold Bachelor's-level degree
- Must be currently enrolled in a Master of Social Work degree program
- Must have knowledge working with GSuite and Microsoft Office
